## After School Care Frequently Asked Questions

1. **When is After School Care (ASC) offered?** SMV's After School Care hours are school days from 2:45 pm - 6:00 pm or until the last student is picked up.
2. **What if I am late for pick-up?** Either email [rdegrave@stmaryeg.org](mailto:rdegrave@stmaryeg.org) or call 414-573-3783.
3. **What if we decide to change days in ASC?** If you wish to change days, please use above email or phone number or call the school office at 262-782-4575.
4. **Are snacks served?** Yes, normally two per day. Due to allergy concerns, students are not allowed to bring their own snacks.
5. **I understand you help kids with homework, are they required to do homework with you?** No it is not a requirement, however most 3rd and 4th graders utilize this resource.
6. **How will my student get to other after school activities?** If the activity takes place on school/parish grounds, the student will be escorted by an employee of ASC.
7. **What if a student takes the bus by mistake?** The bus driver will ensure the student is in the house or secure, if the student needs to be returned to SMV, the driver will bring him/her back.
8. **What if my child becomes sick or injured?** All ASC employees are CPR certified, with adolescent endorsement. We have on file two emergency phone numbers for each student, and one ASC staff person has a medic background.
9. **What activities are offered in ASC?** Typically, the first hour will be spent either on the playground or if inclement weather, in the gym. This is followed by a snack and a storytime for K4-1st graders. The older students then either do homework or play board games. ASC also offers baton twirling lessons and beginning French vocabulary.
