BAPTISM PREPARATION

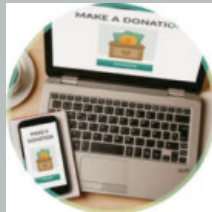

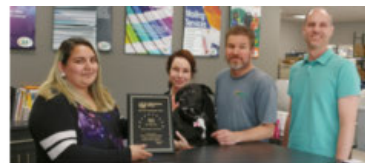
