BAPTISM PREPARATION

Children ages 6 and under: Those seeking to have children baptized should be registered, active members of St. Mary's Visitation Parish. Parents are expected to complete a preparation class, preferably before the birth of the child. The class is offered bi-monthly, upcoming classes include:

The death of a loved one represents a deep loss, and at times, a tragic event. The Church recognizes the need both to remember the soul of the deceased and to assist in healing the human anguish of those who remain behind. At the time of death, the family, directly or through the funeral director, will contact the Parish Office to schedule the day and time of the funeral or Memorial Mass. Once the time has been set, the family will meet with the priest, at which time they will be given the necessary materials to help them plan the funeral liturgy. ADORATION CHAPEL

Sunday, January 7th we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord. Consider how far the Magi had to travel to visit Jesus in Bethlehem and how many sacrifices they had to make to do this. *"Come let us bow down in worship; let us kneel before the Lord who made us. For He is our God and we are the people He shepherds, the flock He guides."* (Psalm 95:6-7) We have the privilege of having Jesus right here in the Blessed Sacrament 24/7 in the St. Mary's Perpetual Adoration Chapel. How many sacrifices are YOU willing to make to visit Him there?



After the Baptism of Our Lord, which we celebrate on January 8th, His Father proclaimed: ***"This is My beloved Son with whom I am well pleased."*** Can God say this about you? Spending time with Jesus in the Adoration Chapel will certainly please Him! Meditate on the words of Pope Benedict XVI: *"Happiness is first of all a gift of God that is received by following the unexpected paths of God's will. These ways are demanding, but they are also a source of deep joy. Look at Mary: invited to take a surprising and disconcerting path, her willingness made her enter a joy that all generations will sing."* At this time of year people traditionally reevaluate their lives and make resolutions for the New Year. Take some time and think of all the reasons why YOU should spend more time with Jesus in the Chapel — and then resolve to "get with the Adoration program" in 2024. 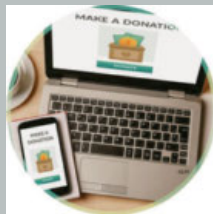


SMV volunteers deliver food from the Feed the Hungry collection to the food pantries.

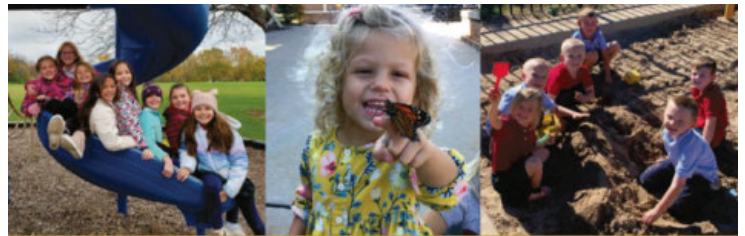



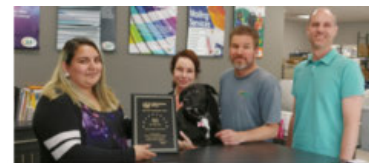
