

Sunday, January 7th we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord. Consider how far the Magi had to travel to visit Jesus in Bethlehem and how many sacrifices they had to make to do this. "Come let us bow down in worship; let us kneel before the Lord who



made us. For He is our God and we are the people He shepherds, the flock He guides." (Psalm 95:6-7) We have the privilege of having Jesus right here in the Blessed Sacrament 24/7 in the St. Mary's Perpetual Adoration Chapel. How many sacrifices are YOU willing to make to visit Him there?

After the Baptism of Our Lord, which we celebrate on January 8th, His Father proclaimed: "This is My beloved Son with whom I am well pleased." Can God say this about you?
