TRUSTEE ELECTIONS

In accordance with Wisconsin State Law, each parish has two lay trustees – the Trustee Secretary and Trustee Treasurer. They serve as the legal Board for the parish along with the Pastor, the Archbishop and the Vicar General of the Archdiocese. Each lay trustee serves a two-year term, which is renewable. Fr. Schumaker has nominated Mr. James Carrig as Trustee Secretary and Mr. Gordon Giampietro as Trustee Treasurer. The parish charter also allows any practicing baptized and confirmed Catholic member of the parish, at least 25 years old, to be nominated in writing by ten or more parish members. Nominations need to be received in the Parish Office by Monday, February 26.

BAPTISM PREPARATION



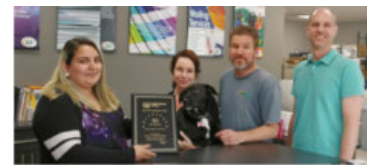
