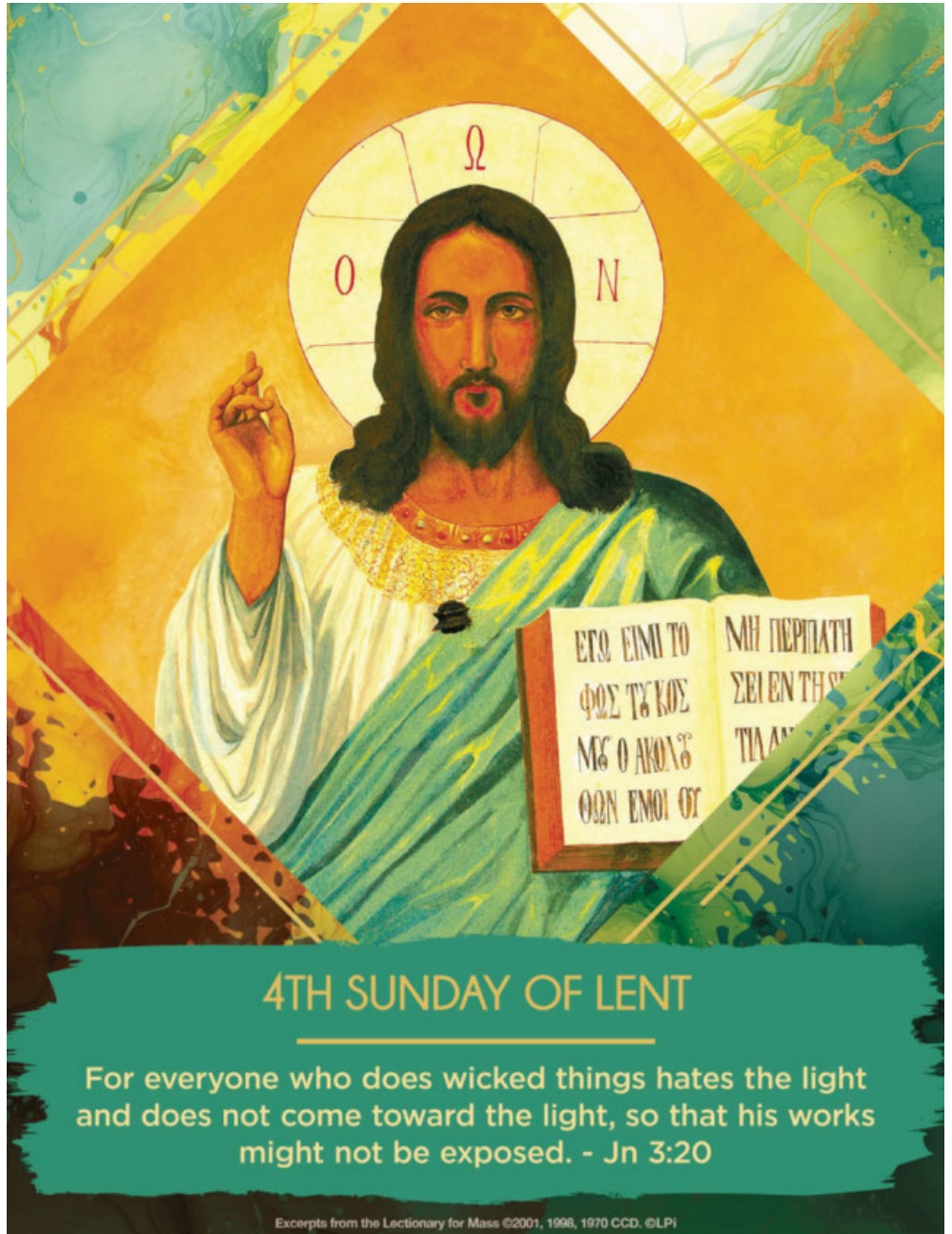

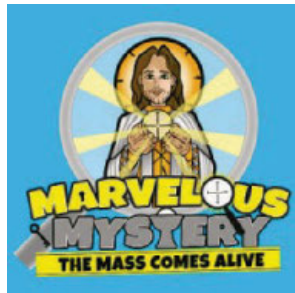
## HOLY THURSDAY FOOT WASHING RITE

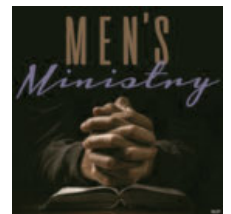
## SAVE THE DATE: VBS IS JUNE 24-28

Once the time has been set, the family will meet with the priest, at which time they will be given the necessary materials to help them plan the funeral liturgy. 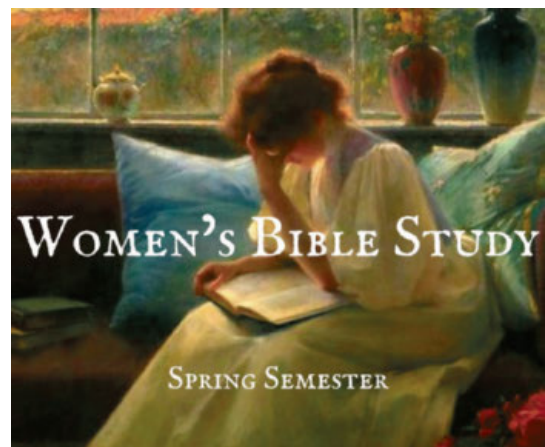

## ADORATION CHAPEL

In his work entitled, "The Great Means of Salvation and Perfection", St. Alphonsus Liguori wrote, *"I say and repeat, and will keep repeating as long as I live, that our whole salvation depends on prayer; and therefore, all writers in their books, all preachers in their sermons, all confessors in their instructions to penitents, should not inculcate anything more strongly than prayer. If you pray, your salvation will be secure, but if you leave off praying, your damnation will be certain."* Jesus is in the Blessed Sacrament in the St. Mary's Perpetual Adoration Chapel 24/7 — the ideal place to do your praying at any hour of the day or night. St. Alphonsus also exhorts us to *"Acquire the habit of speaking to God with familiarity and confidence — as to your dearest and most loving friend. Speak of your life, your plans, your troubles, your joys, your fears. In return, God will speak to you — not that you will hear audible words in your ear, but words that you will clearly understand in your heart."* The peace and quiet that the Chapel provides will enable you to hear what God is telling you. Make use of it often, not only during Lent, but in all seasons of the year.

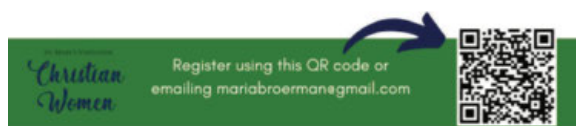

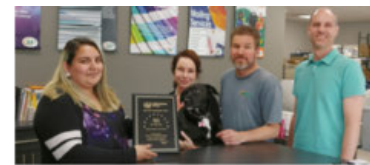
