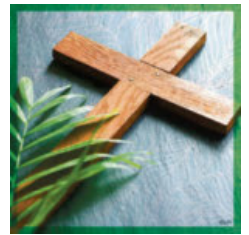

He is great in faith, not because he speaks his own words, but above all because he listens to the words of the Living God."* He will listen to whatever words you utter to him to!

When God wishes to raise a soul to greater heights, He unites it to St. Joseph by giving it a strong love for the good saint."* (St. Peter Julian Eymard) Visit the St. Mary's Perpetual Adoration Chapel and through St. Joseph ask God to shower His special blessings on you, your family, our parish, the entire Church and the whole world! 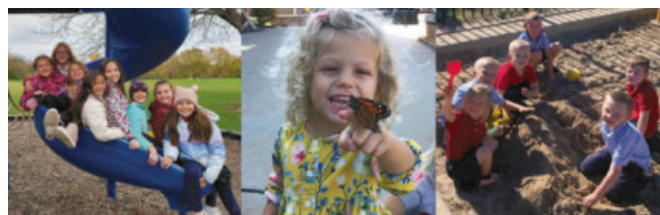
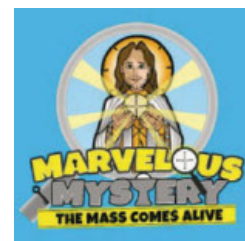

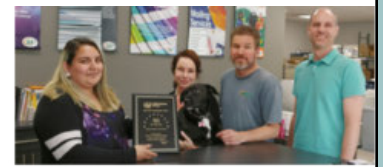
