ADORATION CHAPEL

"I always begin my prayer in silence, for it is in the silence of the heart that God speaks. God is the friend of silence — we need to listen to God because it's not what we say but what God says to us and through us that matters." (St. Teresa of Calcutta)

St. Mary's provides the Perpetual Adoration Chapel — an ideal place to sit in silence and listen to God speak and then speak to Him. Jesus told St. Faustina Kowalska: *"Tell Me all, My child, hide nothing from Me, because My loving Heart, the Heart of your Best Friend is listening to you."* In 1 Peter 5:7 it states: *"Cast all your worries upon Him because He cares for you."* The Psalms state: *"The Lord is good; His kindness endures forever and His faithfulness to all generations."* There are over 10,000 minutes each week. Couldn't you spare just 60 of them to spend an hour with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament in the Adoration Chapel? Could you sign up to fill one of the hours listed below for which we need coverage? BAPTISM PREPARATION

The death of a loved one represents a deep loss, and at times, a tragic event. The Church recognizes the need both to remember the soul of the deceased and to assist in healing the human anguish of those who remain behind. Once the time has been set, the family will meet with the priest, at which time they will be given the necessary materials to help them plan the funeral liturgy. 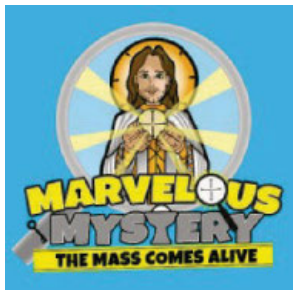

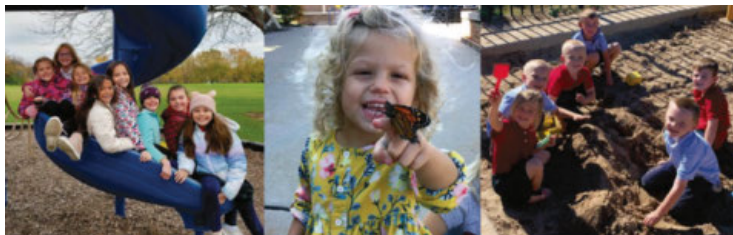
