



## SAFE ENVIRONMENT WEEK

The Archdiocese of Milwaukee recognizes April 21st – April 27th as Safe Environment Awareness Week. Each year in the month of April, which is recognized around the country as child abuse prevention month, we dedicate a week to elevating the general awareness of the Church's efforts to keep our



children safe. We want people to know that we are committed to maintaining safe environments in our parishes and schools through adult child abuse prevention training; criminal background checks for all clergy, volunteers working with minors, and employees; safety training for children in each grade level; and adhering to all mandatory reporting requirement laws.

### Did You Know...

- The Safe Environment Program in the Catholic Church is not only making our parishes and schools safe places for our children, youth and vulnerable adults. We hope that all clergy, employees and volunteers task themselves with protecting the young and vulnerable in their workplaces, neighborhoods, communities and even their own homes. Our goal is greater than just safe environments within the four walls of our parishes and schools, but safer communities for all God's children to live, learn and grow.
- All clergy, employees and volunteers are instructed to contact local law enforcement or Child Protective Services immediately if they are made aware of a child being sexually abused. All bishops, priests and deacons, lay parish/school staffs and volunteers are required to follow the mandatory reporting laws of the State of Wisconsin. In Wisconsin, all clergy and all school employees are considered mandatory reporters and can face legal penalties for failing to report suspected or known child abuse or neglect.




