The foundation of the Elizabeth Ministry is based on the scriptural story of The Visitation. The beauty of Mary's meeting with Elizabeth was that both women realized that there was someone who understood and could share in the miracle of what God was doing for them. The purpose of this ministry is to affirm, assist, encourage and support women and their families in response to their needs during the childbearing years. Prayer is at the heart of this mission.

Members of the Elizabeth Ministry give encouragement and reassurance to women who are pregnant or are caring for healthy or ill newborns; offer support to women or couples dealing with infertility issues or a childless lifestyle; reach out to women or couples who have experienced a miscarriage or death of a child; respond at times of infant or child crisis; support parents involved in the adoption process; empower women to relate to each other, pray for each other and share their faith in a personal way.

Elizabeth Ministers are volunteers from our parish family. They are not counselors, but are present to offer offers prayers, support, compassion and hope through personal visits, cards, phone calls and emails. Elizabeth Ministers are matched with women according to their areas of shared experience. Women become mentors for one another. The confidential sharing of the life experiences brings a caring commitment and a sense of connectedness.
