#### First Holy Communion Clothing Guidelines

First Eucharist is a solemn religious occasion. Clothing should be simple, yet special. Outfits should be dignified, modest, and appropriate. White clothing is a symbol of our Baptism in which we are clothed with Christ. The clothing signifies our new life in Christ, by sharing at the Table of the Lord

Boys	<ul> <li>Dark dress pants</li> <li>White dress shirt</li> <li>Tie</li> <li>Dress shoes</li> <li>Sport coat or suit is optional, but not required.</li> </ul>	
Girls	<ul> <li>White dress - with top of shoulders covered</li> <li>Head accessories are optional, i.e. veil, flowers or similar adornment.</li> <li>No gloves will be allowed during reception of the Eucharist.</li> <li>White dress shoes</li> </ul>
